The Social Sciences major offers an opportunity for students to explore a breadth of courses in Psychology, Sociology, Gerontology, Economics or Political Science. Students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to develop a plan to meet their career goals. The school major may be good preparation for employment or for entry into graduate programs in some disciplines such as law, management and social work. The B.A. in Social Sciences does not provide sufficient depth to prepare for graduate study in any of the social sciences.

Students who complete a degree in Social Sciences will:

Requirements

Students must achieve the following program requirements for all courses listed under Program Requirements and Program Required Courses for the Social Sciences major.

Program Requirements

Major Credits: 36 Major Residency Credits: 16 Minimum GPA: 2.0 Minimum Grade: C-

Program Required Courses

36 total credits in PSY, SOC, GER, ECN, or POL with following distribution:

- 1. Sixteen credits must be earned in one social science discipline.
- 2. Eight credits in a second social science discipline.
- 3. Sixteen credits must be at the 3000 level or higher.
- 4. Balance of the credits selected from any of the social science disciplines.
- 5. Courses in other disciplines that have a strong social science emphasis may be counted toward the major with approval from the Dean.

Degree Requirements
