The Theatre program provides opportunities for any student, including theatre minors and students majoring in other fields, to develop an appreciation for the aesthetics of theatre. Students construct the sets and costumes, create properties and hang lights, manage the box office and house, and perform in the productions. This combination of work, learning, and self-expression is a unique component of the liberal arts education. Through classroom experiences and performances, students develop responsibility for their own work and create collaborative art by working with an entire production team. Course offerings, play selection, and the production process are based in the liberal arts tradition of the College. Students from all disciplines contribute to each play that is produced at The College of St. Scholastica. Students also learn from quest directors and artists, giving them a broad exposure to varying perspectives. Everyone is welcome to participate in the CSS Theatre; onstage, backstage, work study, or in the classroom, we'll help you find your place in the theatre.
