

NURSING ASSISTANT TRAINING

Nursing Assistants, as part of the healthcare team, provide basic patient care under direction of nursing staff. St. Scholastica utilizes LeadingAge Minnesota Foundation's OnTrack (<https://ontracknatraining.com/>), powered by EduCare, an online hybrid model of nursing assistant training. This course will meet both Wisconsin and Minnesota requirements to test to become a certified nursing assistant.
